At the end of June into the first week of July 2022 we did a re-charge retreat to Egypt and Israel with another 24 church members from USA and Mexico. We followed the steps of the Israelites since they got to Egypt, crossed the Red Sea, got to Mount Sinai, and finally entered Canaan and settled in Israel. We visited the holy places and some others with historical value. Jesus had the honor of speaking a short encouraging sermon on a boat in the Sea of Galilee. Also, we visited the only Church of Christ in all Israel located in Nazareth and



worshiped with our brethren there on Sunday. Their hospitality was inspiring.



July through September we continued worshiping at the building and had two new families joined us as we continue working on planing activities and inviting people to come to God and going after those that left the church trying to rescue them. Our numbers are still low, but we continue working to bring more people to Jesus. Attendance regularly fluctuates between 11 to 25 per Sunday.



Online Bible studies continue on Wednesday at 6:00pm through Facebook and postings on Youtube.

On Saturday, September 24th, we had a big event where we invited hispanic congregation in AZ and some areas of North Mexico. We had representation from 9 congregation with an attendance of 80 people. Two guest speakers from Tennessee shared great lessons with us, and we worship together in an amazing time, the like of what we haven't seen since before the Covid-19 pandemic.
